# The 2007 Georgia High School Report Card for Parents

## Overview

The Georgia Public Policy Foundation's *Report Card for Parents* is primarily designed to give parents information about their schools. It also provides valuable information for discussions that will help parents make informed decisions about the quality of public education in Georgia.

The testing and evaluation of Georgia's children generates an enormous amount of statistical data. The *Report Card for Parents* transforms this mountain of data into an understandable ranking of Georgia's public schools. The *High School Report* is a numerical ranking of 369 public schools.

The primary measure of student achievement for this report is the average of 1) the percentage of students in the school that score in the Meets or Exceeds range in English Language Arts and 2) the percentage of students in the school that score in the Meets or Exceeds range in math on the Georgia High School Graduation Test (GHSGT).

The percentage of students passing the GHSGT is an indicator of how well each school is preparing all students in basic skills. The "Exceeds" distinction is meant to challenge all Georgia high school students to "be the best" through the addition of a higher standard against which students, schools and systems can measure their performance.

Because there is a strong link between poverty and test scores (the higher the poverty rate, the lower the test scores), the report includes two other criteria *for information purposes only*. The first is the poverty rate — the percentage of students in each school who qualify for the federal free/reduced-price lunch program. The second is a poverty index that measures how well a school is performing relative to its poverty rate. (See pgs.3-4 for a detailed explanation.) All information in the report is from

the 2005–2006 school year.

# How Parents Can Use This Report

To judge the quality of their children's schools, parents must have quality information about academic performance. Student achievement is the touchstone for evaluating the success of all education efforts. To improve public education for all students we must know whether students are progressing every year. For the vast majority of parents, assessing the quality of a school can often be a difficult task with unfamiliar terms and voluminous data. This report serves to provide parents with the simple facts which will aid in the assessment of the education received by their children. In this *Report Card*, schools are ranked by clear, objective results, and parents are presented with a statistically reliable, annual measurement of student progress.

It is important to remember that many factors affect a school's performance. Any questions or concerns arising from this report should first be discussed with teachers, principals and local school board members and visits to the school before drawing definitive conclusions.

We believe parents should become actively involved in their schools and resist being passive, uninformed consumers. The information in this report should be used to open a dialogue between parents, teachers, administrators, elected officials and civic organizations.

# Definition of Terms

**Achievement Score.** Average of: 1) the percentage of students in the school that score in the Meets/Exceeds range in English Language Arts and 2) the percentage of students in the school that score in the Meets/Exceeds range in math on the Georgia High School Graduation Test.

**Percentage Exceeding Standards.** Average of:

- The percentage of students in the school that exceed standards in English Language Arts on the GHS GT.
- The percentage of students in the school that exceed standards in math on the GHS GT.

**Poverty Rate.** The percentage of students eligible to receive free/reduced-price lunch provides an indicator of the poverty level of the students attending the school.

**Poverty Index.** Measures how well a school is performing relative to its poverty rate. A score above zero indicates better than expected performance, below zero indicates lower than expected performance, and zero indicates that the school is performing as expected.

**State Rank.** The rank is determined by the Achievement Score. The % Exceeds serves as a tiebreaker. If both of these criteria are equal, there is a tie and the schools are listed with equal rank in alphabetical order by school name.

# Additional Information

## ▶ **How should I interpret the ranking?**

There are several ways to evaluate your school's ranking. First, look at the school's progress over time. Is the school improving or declining? Second, compare your school to other schools of similar size and poverty percentage. Finally, there is no substitute for personally visiting schools and talking to teachers, administrators, parents and students.

## ▶ **Why was my school not listed in this report?**

In order to be included in this report, a school must have 2006 testing data for the 11th grade. For example, a school that just began operation this fall would not be included.

## ▶ **Why is some information not available for my school?**

Missing data may result if the school were unable to administer the test or if fewer than 10 students participated in the test.

## ▶ **Why do we focus on test scores?**

To improve public education for all students, we must know whether students are learning every year. Well-made tests are an analytical tool, enabling teachers to diagnose students' weaknesses and parents to monitor the achievement gains of their children.

## ▶ **Why are charter schools included in the report?**

A charter school is a public school that is free from most state and local regulations, and in return for that freedom, the school must meet certain accountability standards that are defined in its charter.

## Notes on the Student Data

- Data were provided by the Office of Student Achievement and the Georgia Department of Education.
- "All Students" refers to all students who were tested.
- Test results for less than 10 students are not reported.
- Poverty rate is reported as the percentage of students eligible to receive free- or reduced-price lunches who actually took the High School Graduation tests. This percentage is calculated by dividing the number of eligible students who took the tests (as reported to the Department of Education) by the total school population who took the tests (as reported to the Department of Education). If a school enrolls fewer than 10 students eligible for free or reduced lunch, their poverty rate is reported as "Too Few Students."
